### **Tournament Rules**

- 5/6 games will consist of two 18 minute periods; 3 minute running time shifts
- Each coach will chose a “Player of the Game” (not previously selected) from the opposing team
- HAVE FUN!!!!
- In the event of incimate weather leading to the cancellation of the tournament, all fees paid will be refunded
- The following rules apply to 7/8 only:
  - 7/8 Games will consist of three 12 minute periods; 2 minute running time shifts
  - Two points awarded for a win, one point for a tie, zero points for a loss
  - No double shifting unless fewer than 10 skaters; Fair play rule in effect
  - Injured player causing a stoppage in play will go to the bench for the remainder of the shift
  - No overtime during round robin
  - Tie in standings will be decided by
    - Most wins, if still tied;
    - Win in game between tied teams, if still tied;
    - Most goals for, if still tied;



- Least goals against, if still tied;
  - Coin toss

- Overtime in playoff round will be 5 minute sudden victory. If game is tied at end of 5 minute overtime a shootout will take place
